Item #5 – Legal Proceedings

This is in relation to the Petition for Review (with Prayer for the issuance of a Temporary Restraining Order and/or Preliminary Injunction) filed with the Court of Appeals by Harvest All, et al. on 10 September 2015 to reverse and set aside the Pasig Regional Trial Court Resolution dismissing Harvest All, et al.'s Complaint (with application for the issuance of Writ of Preliminary Mandatory Injunction and Temporary Restraining Order/Writ of Preliminary Injunction) against Alliance Select Foods International, Inc., its Directors and Corporate Secretary ("ASFII" or "Company").

ASFII was informed on 15 December 2015 at the end of business day that its counsels received a Resolution dated 15 December 2015 from the Court of Appeals (Third Division), the dispositive portion of which reads:

"In light of the allegations and arguments raised, We resolve to GRANT the petitioners' plea for the issuance of a temporary restraining order, effective for a period of 60 days from notice, enjoining the parties to maintain and preserve the status quo pending resolution of this petition for review. It is settled that the sole objective of the injunctive remedy is not to correct a wrong already consummated, or to redress an injury already sustained, or to punish wrongful acts already committed, but to preserve and protect the rights of the litigants during the pendency of the case. Here, the issue on whether the trial court properly dismissed the complaint for lack of jurisdiction for non-payment of docket fees must be resolved the soonest before this case becomes moot and academic or a decision herein becomes ineffectual through the conduct of the Annual Stockholders' Meeting scheduled on December 16, 2015.

FOR THESE REASONS, let a temporary restraining order be issued in favor of the petitioners, after posting a bond, in the amount of P1,000,000.00 to answer for whatever damages the respondents may suffer should petitioners be adjudged not entitled to such relief.

Let a copy of the resolution be furnished to the parties and their respective counsels. Petitioners are hereby directed to file the bond within 10 days from notice.

With the filing of the required pleadings, the petition is now SUBMITTED for decision.
