REPORT OF FACTUAL FINDINGS

Gentlemen:

We update the procedures we have performed, in our report dated February 11, 2004, and agreed with you and enumerated below relating to the proposed increase in the authorized capital stock of Alliance Tuna International, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Company") from P1.6 million divided into 1.6 million shares to P300 million divided into 300 million shares all with a par value of P1 per share. Our engagement was undertaken in accordance with the Philippine Standards on Auditing applicable to agreed-upon procedures engagement. The procedures performed were intended to verify the cash subscriptions for the increase in the authorized capital stock and have been carried out in conformity with the Securities and Exchange Commission's "Guide to be Followed in the Verification of the Payment on Subscription for the Proposed Increase of Capital Stock." These procedures have been made solely to assist you in preparing necessary documents and support for your plan of increase in the authorized capital stock and are summarized as follows:

- 1. We obtained the list of cash subscriptions prepared by the Company, and we verified the receipt of the cash through official receipts to establish whether this list represents the summary of all cash subscriptions received by the Company.
- 2. We traced the cash received for subscriptions through certificate of deposit from a local bank and checked the necessary bank statements to determine that these have been deposited intact.
- We checked the cash receipts book to ascertain whether proper entries have been made on the cash received for subscriptions.
- 4. We verified the cash disbursement book to substantiate that these infusions of capital have not been originally disbursed by the Company to the subscribers in the form of loans and/or advances and returned by the same subscribers to the Company as payment on additional subscriptions for the said increase in authorized capital stock; or that these were subsequently disbursed or returned in the form of loans and/or advances.
- 5. We reviewed the cash position of the Company from February 11, 2004 (date of our previous report) to the date of our examination and reconciled to the bank reconciliation statement at February 29, 2004, two months after the date of the meeting approving the increase in capital stock of the Company.



We report our findings below:

- a) With respect to item 1, we found the list of subscriptions to represent the summary of all cash subscriptions received by the Company. Refer to Attachment A.
- b) With respect to item 2, we found the amounts have been in the form of cash. The Company's banks received the cash and such were deposited immediately at the time of receipt, which corresponds to the date of the official receipts and recording in the cash receipts book.
- c) With respect to item 3, we found that proper entries have been made in the books of account of the Company.
- d) With respect to item 4, we have verified the cash disbursement book at February 29, 2004 to substantiate that these infusions of capital have not been originally disbursed by the Company to the subscribers in the form of loans and/or advances and returned by the same subscribers to the Company as payment on additional subscriptions for the said increase in authorized capital stock; or that these were subsequently disbursed or returned in the form of loans and/or advances.
- e) With respect to item 5, we found no exceptions to the cash position of the Company as of February 29, 2004, as well as the bank reconciliation at February 29, 2004. Refer to Attachment B.

Because the above procedures do not constitute either an audit or a review made in accordance with Philippine Standards on Auditing, we do not express any assurance on the financial statements of the Company taken as a whole.

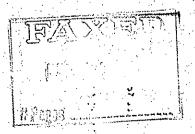
